Dr. Teddi Deka and Dr. James Carviou host trip to New York City

Dr. Carviou's JOU428 (Travel Journalism) and Dr. Deka's PSY222 (Psychology of Gender) classes were both cross-listed with HON395. The classes traveled to New York City from May 6th through May 11th to experience New York City through a gendered lens.

In all, 20 students visited journalism sites including the Paley Center for Media and psychology of gender sites including the Stonewall National Memorial, in addition to tourist sites overlapping the theme such as Ellis Island, 9/11 Memorial, and the Museum of Modern Art.

When students returned, they presented enhancements to their projects based on one or more of the sites they visited in NYC. Both of the faculty members value learning experiences that highlight and deepen the understanding of course concepts.
