FOR STUDENTS Rights for Pregnant Students

- Under Title IX and the Missouri Western Sexual Misconduct Policy you can expect:
 - To continue you education free from discrimination by the University because you are (or were) pregnant.
 - To be provided leave from the classroom for as long as your doctor says it is medically necessary for pregnancy, childbirth, abortion, or related conditions, including recovery.
 - o To be readmitted after medical absences related to pregnancy, abortion, childbirth and recovery, with the same status you held when you left (no penalty for leave).
 - To be provided the same types of special services that are provided to students with other temporary medical conditions, if you so choose.
 - To have access to a clean and secure, designated lactation space as well as time to use it. Currently there is a designated lactation space in Esry Student Health Center, available Monday thru Thursday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Check back later as more space is secured.
